

Leather Policy

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Leather and hides are usually by-products of meat production. This means the animals are not reared and slaughtered explicitly for their leather and hides; rather, their hides are the by-product of the food industry and are reused instead of being disposed of.

There are species of animal mainly hunted or reared for their hides and often slaughtered under cruel conditions (such as crocodile, lizard and snake).

Kathmandu will only use leather and hides which are a by-product of the food industry.
